Q. When was the Indian Tree dinnerware pattern introduced?—Linda, Greenville, Mass.

A. Since the early 1800s, English and American tabletops have been enlivened with Tree pattern dinnerware services. The famed Coalport firm marketed the design in 1801! Oriental in flavor, the design featured a gnarled tree, thought to be a peony tree, in brown with pink peonies, green foliage and other motifs. The border consisted of a Chinese fret-work motif. Throughout the 19th century as potters including Doulton, Johnson Bros. and Maddox produced the design, slight variations occurred. The Indian Tree design has branched out into a choice collectible! Value guide: butter dish, Burgess & Leigh, \$75.

Q. I buy every jack-in-the-pulpit vase I can find. Would a price list be available in this category?—Joan, Kingston, Ky.

A. This American botany specimen from the lily family has been inspiring glass artisans since the late 19th century. Eye-catching jack-in-the-pulpit vases can be found in full bloom on flea market tabletops! Value guide: cased, pink with ruffled rim, leaf with pink and white blossoms, \$100; cranberry, ribbed, 7 inches tall, \$90; green opalescent, 9½ inches tall, \$80; pink satin, swirled sides, \$100; vaseline, opalescent, 8 inches tall, \$80.

People United for the Arts (P.U.F.A.) will hold their monthly meeting October 13 at 7:30 pm at the Donegal High School.

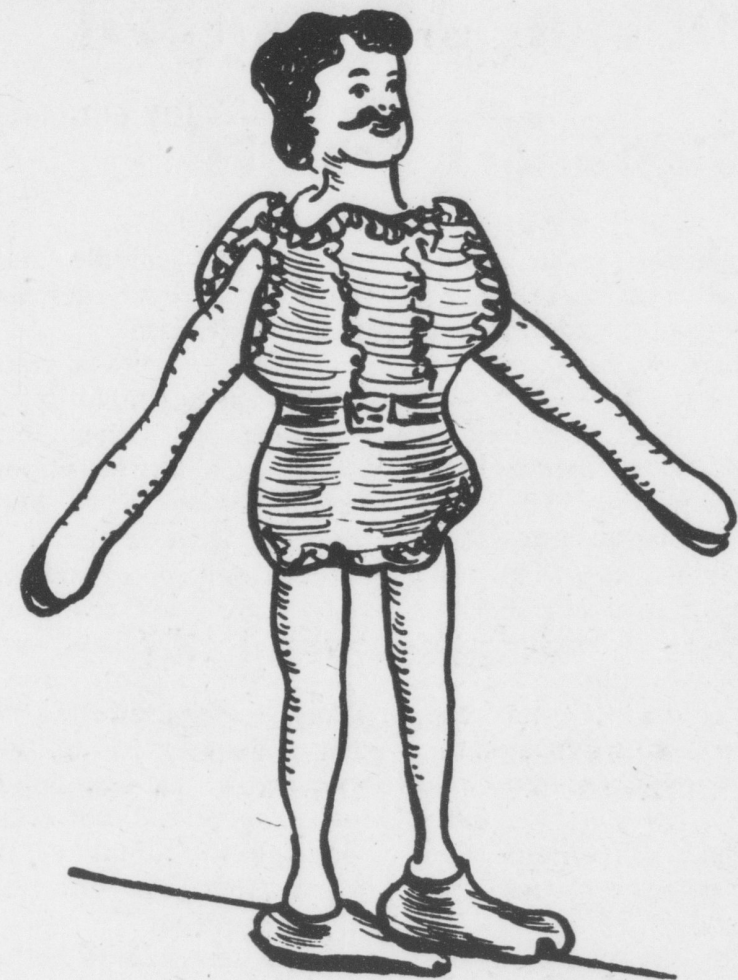

Customers clamored for additional characters and animals. Before long a Ringmaster, Lion Tamer, Gent Acrobat, Lady Acrobat and Lady Circus Rider were performing daily on parlor floors! They were made with wooden or bisque heads. The latter are somewhat scarcer. To add to the flavor there was a collapsible tent, with a sawdust ring. Advertisement proclaimed that this indoor spectacular boasted 10,001 outstanding tricks! Value guide: Gent Acrobat, wooden head, \$165.

Q. We have a sewing kit advertising Coca-Cola featuring an American eagle along with the wording "U. S. Army". Can you enlighten us about this garage sale find?—Mr. and Mrs. F. G., Cherry Hill, Ohio.

A. With the outbreak of World War II, the Coca-Cola Company was right up front with a barrage of advertising articles. Several sewing kits were issued. Your khaki-colored leatherette style, bearing "U. S. Army" and an American eagle in gold, was pressed into service whenever a shirt button popped prior to inspection! Locating one complete with its thread, buttons and needles for under \$25, places you in the top rank of collectors!
