## Maytown Halloween surprises



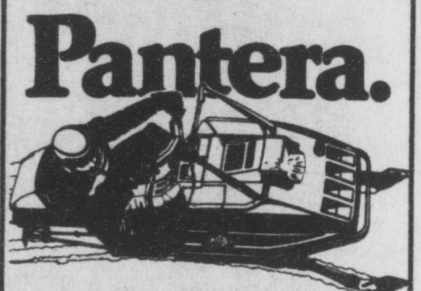

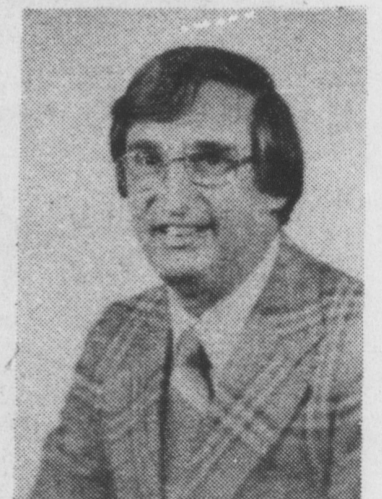
