



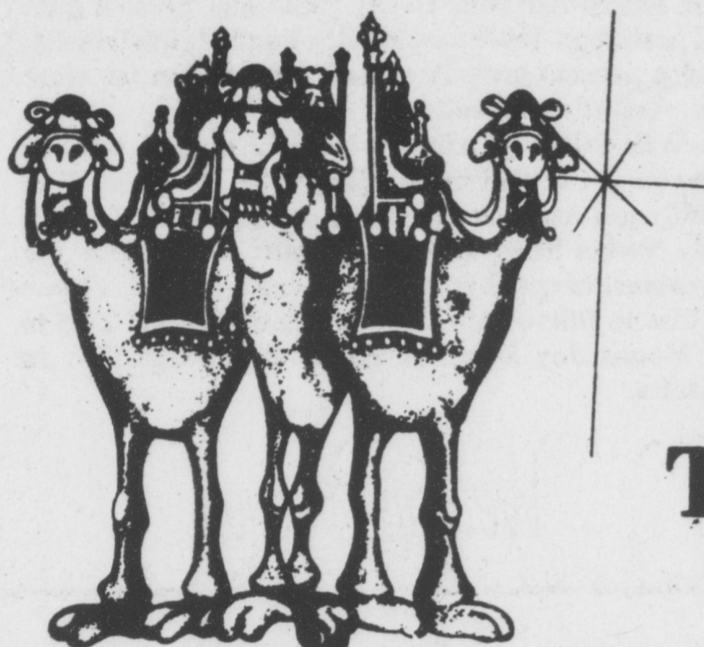

year's budget. Bids for the Grandview boiler replacement will be opened at the December 4 board meeting.

ZEMCO, the company doing work on the high school track, has placed some rough patching to the track surface trouble spots. They plan to return and complete this patching, and then apply the color surface to the repaired areas.

Two sample patches have been installed at the high school tennis court surfaces for testing over the winter.

The next board meeting, on December 4, will be a reorganization meeting. It will be the only meeting for the month.
