WHERE THE KAISER RULES.

Golden and diamond weddings were celebrated by 614 couples in Prussia last year, and the state contributed medals to each husband and wife.

Germany's two African possessions are nearly equal in size, the sphere of influence on the east coast having an estimated area of 345,000 square miles; on the west coast the territory embraced is about 342,000 square miles.

Nearly 8,000 persons committed suicide last year in Germany. Roughly speaking, the proportion of men to women was three to one. More than a quarter of the suicides were persons mentally infirm. Nearly one-half had been addicted to drink.

RIVERS AND RIVER SYSTEMS.

There are five rivers in the world which drain over a million square miles. They are the Amazon, La Plata, Obi, Congo and Mississippi.

The Paraguay river, so called from a republic of the same name on its banks, is 1,800 miles in length. At points in its lower course it is from five to fifteen miles wide.

The outflow of the Nile varies from 16,000 cubic feet a second in June to 400,000 in September. From these figures the value of the new Assouan dam in preventing this gigantic waste will be plain.

The Mississippi is the longest river in the world, but estimated by the amount of water discharged into the sea, ranks third only, the Amazon discharging 1,000,000 cubic feet a second, the La Plata 850,000, to the Congo 700,000.
