Daily News.

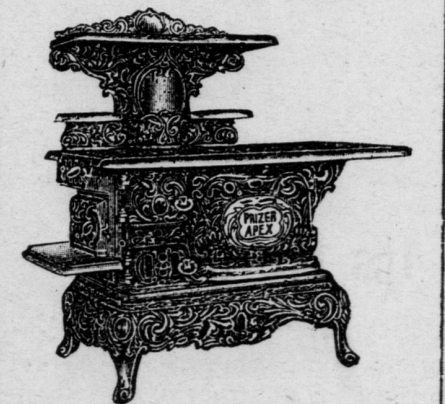
