A JOINT RESOLUTION Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of th Commonwealth.

SECTION 1-Be it resolved by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth in General Assembly met, That the following is proprovisions of the eighteenth article thereof :

Amendment One to Article Eight, Section One. Add at the end of the first paragraph of said sectio fter the words ''shall be entitled to a vote at all elec the really fine distinctions of yachting tions," the words "subject, however, to such laws occur and there are actually but few requiring and regulating the registration of elector as the General Assembly may enact," so that the said section shall read as follows

SECTION 1-Qualifications of Electors. Every male citizen, twenty-one years of age, possessing the fol-owing qualifications, shall be entitled to vote at all lections, subject, however, to such laws requiring nd regulating the registration of electors as the Gen eral Assembly may enact : 1-He shall have been a citizen of the United State

at least one month. 2-He shall have resided in the State one year (or, having previously been a qualified elector or native born citizen of the State, he shall have removed there-from and returned, then six months) immediately

receding the election. 3—He shall have resided in the election district where he shall offer to vote at least two months immediately preceding the election.

4-If twenty-two years of age and upwards, he shall have paid within two years a State or County tax, which shall have been assessed at least tw months and paid at least one month before the election Amendment Two to Article Eight, Section Seven. 
