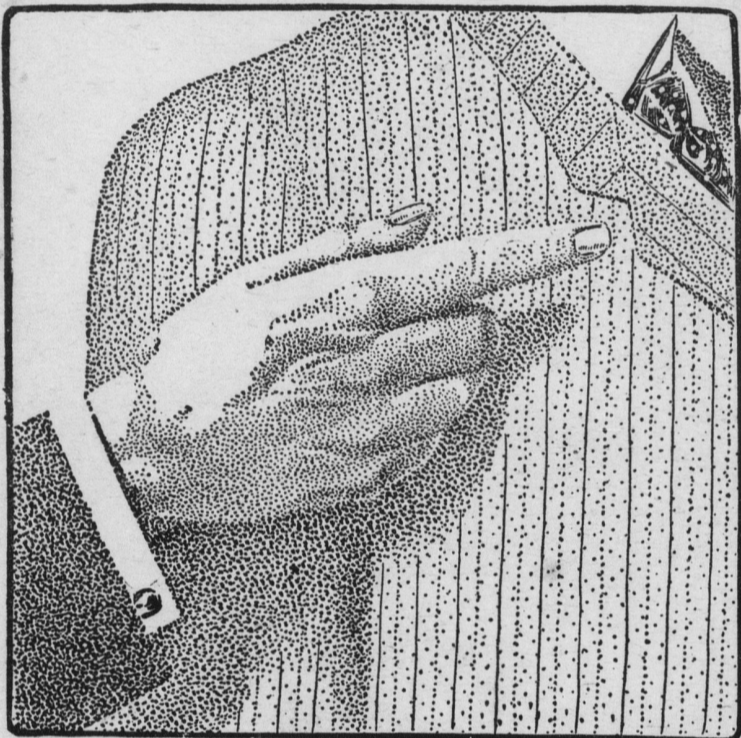

### Danger of Orifaction.

Dr. Braunstein, of Wepperturth, according to the London Mail, has been arrested on a charge of murdering his wife, whose body was cremated by his instructions. 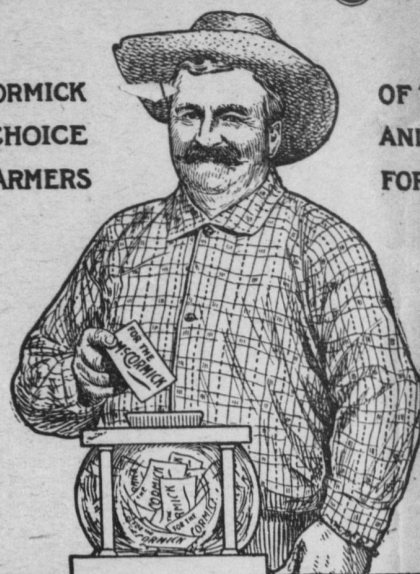

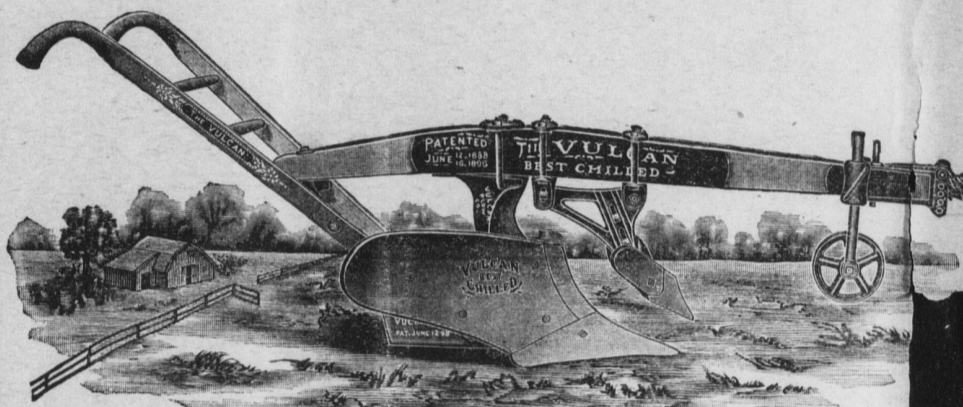
