THE LANCASTER FAIR

Promises a Big Time at the County Seat Next Week

The Lancaster Fair management has made a wise move in reducing the price of admission from 50 to 25 cents and it will result in a very large attendance. The new race track is one of the best in the state and numerous buildings have been erected, including a fine big grand stand, 120 stables, big exhibition building, etc. For the fair many huge tents will be put up. There is running water on the ground and every other convenience. There will be an immense display of horses, cattle, swine and sheep, farming implements and machinery, fruits and vegetables. The big event of the week will be the races. Eleven of them will be for purses of \$400 each and there will be three running races and three county races for horses without records. Tuesday, the opening day, will be a general holiday. All the schools in the city and most of those in the county will close and 20,000 free tickets to school children have been sent out. Many prominent men will visit the fair, among them being Governor Stuart, and representatives of the agricultural departments of the state and national governments.

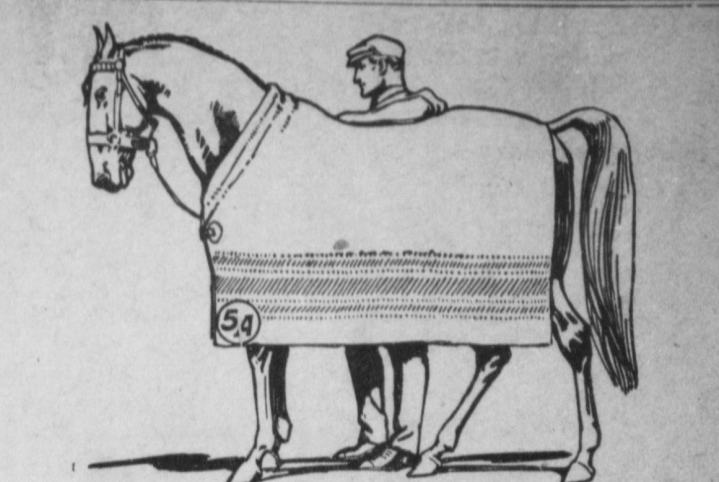
