Now, November 12, 1910, it is ordered by the Court that the terms of the Court of Common Pleas, in and for the County of Lancaster, for trials by jury, for the year A. D. 1911, shall be as follows, to wit:

Court of Oyer and Terminer, Quarter Sessions and General Jail Delivery, for Jury Trial, 1911.

One week, commencing Monday, September 11, 1911.

One week, commencing Monday, November 20, 1911.

Equity Courts for Jury Trial, 1911

One week, commencing Monday, March 6, 1911.

One week, commencing Monday, October 2, 1911.

All cases to be put at issue for jury trial must be placed on the issue list at least forty days before the week of trial.

Argument Courts for the Year, A. D. 1911

One week, commencing Monday, March 20, 1911.

Court for Granting Tavern Licenses, 1911

And at no other time or times.

It is also ordered by the Court that all jurors who are summoned, and fail to attend and serve, shall (unless excused by the Court) be fined the sum of fifteen (15) dollars. And, that all jurors who attend Court, and fail to be present and answer when called for service in the trial of a cause, shall forfeit one day's pay for every failure to answer, unless a legal or sufficient reason be given to the Court for such absence or failure to answer.

It is also ordered that the Prothonotary shall cause the foregoing order to be published, by one insertion, in each of ten newspapers (one German and nine English) published weekly in the city of Lancaster and in the County of Lancaster, and four daily newspapers in the City of Lancaster, and also in the "Lancaster Law Review," and also furnish each of the Judges and members of the bar with a copy of the same, printed in good type in pamphlet form.

The bills for such printing and publication to be presented to the County Commissioners for examination, and if found correct, an order for their payment shall issue.
