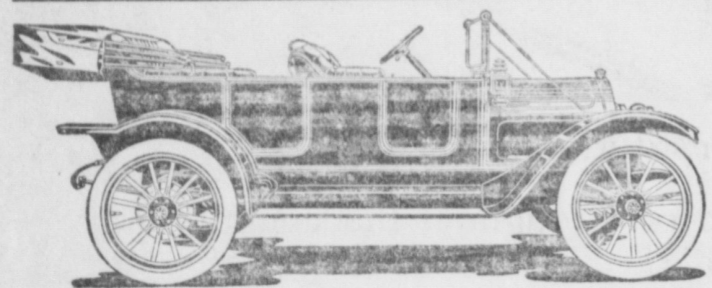

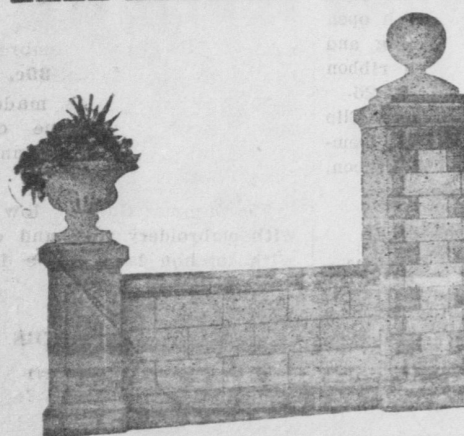

HOME HEALTH CLUB

By Dr. David Reeder, La Porte, Ind.

NIGHT SWEATS—Lately the Home Health Club has had numerous applications for remedy for night sweats. This weakening annoyance is caused by lack of vital force in the nerves of the skin, but can be quickly stopped in a very simple way. The application of diluted acetic acid to the skin is always safely cooling, besides it brings increased activity and is altogether highly sanitary, properly used. In night sweats however, there is far too much activity of the skin without apparent provocation. Hence the remedy must have other simple ingredients that will give new life and tone to the nerves underlying the skin and permeating it; that will increase the general activity and prevent rapid cooling. This result will be found in the simple combination of common table salt, cayenne pepper and vinegar. In the salt is the material that prevents the rapid evaporation of the vinegar and therefore prevents the unpleasant burning sensation that the pepper would induce. The pepper applied as will be here directed, is a tonic for the nerves, and in the nerves, and in the acid is the cleansing, purifying, that enables the pepper to penetrate the pores and scarf skin in a manner to reach and stimulate the nerves as a tonic.

Take a tablespoonful of the salt, a teaspoonful of pulverized cayenne and a half-pint of good vinegar. Mix these together in a half-pint of boiling water. Let the mixture stand a few minutes then strain it so as to remove the granular substance of the pepper; with the liquid, sponge the patient, at bedtime.

Generally one treatment thus prescribed will stop the night sweats but it is better, for a more certain and effective cure, to use the remedy for three or four more consecutive nights. The effect will be very gratifying.

Some of the symptoms which you have described would indicate that the cause of your suffering is either worms or tape worm. Would suggest that you fast for a couple of days and then take a good big dose castor oil, then watch the stools for segments of tape worm, or ordinary round worms. If you will write to me again stating just what you found to be the condition I will tell you what you should do to overcome either condition.

I would like to ask you about eating eggs. They do not seem to agree with me, have tried cooking them all sorts of ways, also raw with milk. I am inclined to constipation if I get at all bilious. I feel after eating an egg as if all my nerves were tied up in knots and strained as hard as possible, then I have sick headache; sometime the feeling does not come on for a day or two, and sometimes slightly after eating one egg, then if in a day or two I eat another it gets worse. When I eat deviled eggs, they do not seem to disturb me. Do you suppose there is any real reason why I cannot eat them? I like them, and they are so nourishing and convenient to use. I have been doctoring lately for kidney trouble, because my kidneys did not seem to eliminate properly; urine shows some uric acid crystals, but no sign of any other kidney trouble. I am fifty years old, unmarried, 59 inches tall, weigh 100 lbs. have fairly good appetite, but do not sleep well, have sallow complexion.

Some persons cannot eat eggs, although some dietists claim that this condition is caused by idiosyncrasy only, but I am not inclined to agree with that opinion. I have seen cases in which people who have partaken of only a small particle of egg without their knowledge and the results have been very serious. The eggs seem to be veritable poison to some people.

I would suggest a milk, fruit and nut diet for a period of three months, after which you may be able to eat eggs with impunity. One dear old lady told me she did not have any impunity to eat with them. Possibly this difficulty will not appear to you.

While using fruit and milk diet you should use an abundance of lemons and oranges. The acid of these fruits aid in digesting the milk.

I would suggest that you drink more water, sip it slowly, but do not drink anything while eating except milk, sipping it slowly also.

Roads need a "Stitch in Time"
The ceaseless wearing out process which roads undergo is argument enough against the once a year patchwork in township districts and even in boroughs. The constant employment of roads point significantly toward the old saying, "a stitch in time," etc., for the rut of today by reason of steady traffic is the impassable condition of tomorrow. A shovelful of mixed sand and clay, or the same quantity of crushed stone applied as soon as a defect becomes noticeable, would mean a road in good shape the entire year, and a vast saving besides. The once a year road gang employment makes the highway unfit for use immediately after the useless work of applying worn-out material to elevate the middle of the road for the necessary crown. The task is too great to be satisfactorily accomplished by the annual spring or post-harvest effort. A lesser force employing suitable materials would render a greater road efficiency and would remove the long wait for much needed repairs in both seeding and harvest period. One stretch of road well repaired would give sufficient time to fix others, and would be more valuable than several lengths poorly patched.

The election of road masters who would devote every day of their term of office in actual road work, would be a vast improvement over the custom of intermittent official supervision by those, whose attention to the highways is interfered with by reason of crop and other affairs.

Had Loot in Church
Over a year ago the cigar factory of John B. Fralich, at Mastersonville, was entered and robbed of several thousand cigars. Mr. Fralich at that time also kept the village hotel, but now conducts the Sporting Hill hotel. On Tuesday while housecleaning at the church in Mastersonville the cigars were discovered hidden in the attic of that edifice, the thieves evidently having put them there for safe keeping until all had been forgotten about the theft.
