

#### Good roads and the postoffice, especially the rural delivery, have be-Mount Joy come inseparably linked. With the increasing number of R. F. D. FRANK E. LEFEVRE, Prop.

routes the rural communities have begun to take an interest in good roads equal to that of the automobilist, especially since the Post Office Department requires that all roads on which rural delivery is established shall be maintained in Accommodations for Man and Bon condition to be traveled throughout the year with facility and safety.

Since the withdrawal of the rural mail delivery in a township of York and Piel's Celebrated New York Gen County on account of its poor roads the inhabitants of that community have been brought to a realization of the value of good roads. Supervisors in other communities where bad roads are suffered can profit from this incident.

P. V. DeGraw, Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, under whose jurisdicion is the rural delivery service, states that there is little if any excuse in he majority of cases for the existence of bad roads, that some five or six years ago the department adopted the policy of insisting that the roads on which rurual delivery is in operation shall be kept in good repair, else to withdraw service therefrom and also to cooperate with State highway commissions, good roads associations, local highway officials, and others interested in securing the improve- sarietta Street ment of highways and to encourage postmasters and rural carriers to do likewise. The department very much desires that postmasters, rural carriers, and substitute carriers shall not only constitute themselves apostles of good roads and spread the propaganda, but that they shall by their works arouse interest and simulation in others. Many postmasters and rural carriers have Ind. 1877 been instrumental in forming good roads clubs and associations, the results of which have been vast improvement in the condition of the highways, and in several notable incidents the appropriation of enormous sums of money for the rebuilding and improvement of enitre county highway systems.

While these improvements have rebounded to the greatest benefits Branch Store at E.
