




CARE OF THE POULTRY HOUSE

Lice and Mites Cause More Losses Than All 'Other Things Combined-Spray Is Urged.

(By J. S. JEFFREY.) It is quite possible to have the best poultry kept in well-built houses, well fed, and still not get any profit or pleasure from them.
