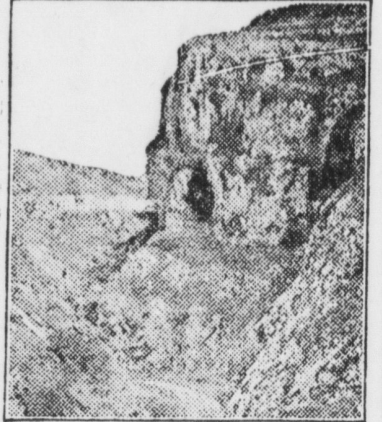
ABILITY TO COOK SAVES HER
