
**VALUE OF POULTRY PRODUCTS** 

Poor Methods of Preparing and Marketing Deprive Poultryman of Much of His Profits.

(By F. H. STONEBURN.) Poultry products of various kinds form one of the greatest crops produced upon American farms. The ever increasing number of farms and plants devoted exclusively to poultry keeping produce large amounts of high grade goods, although these are inconsiderable when compared with the vast supply coming from the small flocks scattered upon the farms and in the villages throughout the country.
