

Will Abandon Conewago Station
 Since the Pennsylvania Railroad company gained control of the Cornwall and Lebanon, rumors are that they have proposed abandoning the Conewago station and extending their lines to Elizabethtown, says the Harrisburg Patriot.

Should this plan be executed, three stations on the Cornwall and Lebanon will be done away with and instead of running to Mt. Gretna, from Conewago, the line will

run from Elizabethtown to Bellaire and then by the way of the Cornwall and Lebanon to Mt. Gretna. The three stations to be cut out will be Mt. Vernon, Aberdeen and Beverly, all of them between Conewago and Bellaire.

Conewago has only a station and a small lunch room. The only business done at this point is transfer. Under the new plan all the baggage would be handled at Elizabethtown.
