Railroad vs. Highway Maintenance

The suggestion has often been made that highway officials could follow with profit the example of railroads in maintenance work. Track, ties and roadbeds are not allowed to be otherwise than in good condition and careful watch is kept to make repairs promptly, as soon as the need becomes apparent. The great railroads have found that this policy pays and the best highway experts realize the same policy to be true in regard to highways.

At this time of year officials of the maintenance of way departments of the railroads are placing the tracks and roadbeds in good condition after the winter months. Extra men are carried on the pay rolls and the daily hours of employment increased. It is a negligent road official who has not started the repair of the roads with which he has been entrusted. Ruts and holes in the macadam roads need attention; the crown of the road needs restoring; and ditches should be cleaned in order to carry away quickly the deluge of water from a summer's heavy thunderstorm before much damage can be done. It is a great mistake, too, to put the working of the earth road off until August or September. The surface is then baked hard and dry. It is not only difficult to work but is unsatisfactory work when done. Earth which is loose and dry will remain dusty as long as the dry weather lasts and then turn to mud as soon as the rains begin. By using the road machine or drag in the spring while the soil is soft and damp, the surface is more easily shaped and soon packs down into a dry, hard crust which is less liable to become dusty in summer or muddy in winter, and a maximum of comfort and satisfaction is afforded users of the road.

SUMMER NORMAL SCHOOL

Was Opened at Maytown Monday, April 28

Prof. John S. Simons, opened a Summer Normal School at Maytown on April 28th. A fine enrollment of students has already been made, and the school promises to be a big success.
