Chromic Iron Ore Mined for Meta lurgical and Chemical Uses-Production increased 70 per cent in Mi

More chromium ore is now used in the United States in chemistry than for metallurgy, it is consumed in the manufacture of pigments dves, and various chemical compounds, and also in tanning light leather, rend ing it tough and resistant moisture. Most chromium pigment are very permanent. Chromium is used metallurgically in making chromium alloys and furnace linings the latter either in the form of chrome bricks or of irregular coarse and fine fragments of chromite hammered into place without the use of cementing material.
