PEACH BUDS ARE FROZEN

Shwilkey Rumbleacek Has To Local Fruit Crop Doubtless Crippled By Cold Weather

> It has been definitely ascertained thru reports from various sections of the country that the local peach crop this year will be a failure because of the extremely cold weather which prevailed in this section during the middle of the week Many of the largest fruit growers of the county, as well as those in other parts of the state, have examined the buds on their trees and report that most of the peach buds show signs of having been killed by the zero weather. In most cases the fatal black spot. indicative of the bud having been frozen, appears, and there is little hope for anything like a good crop. This will be a considerable loss in profit to this locality as the crop is usually quite large here each year.
