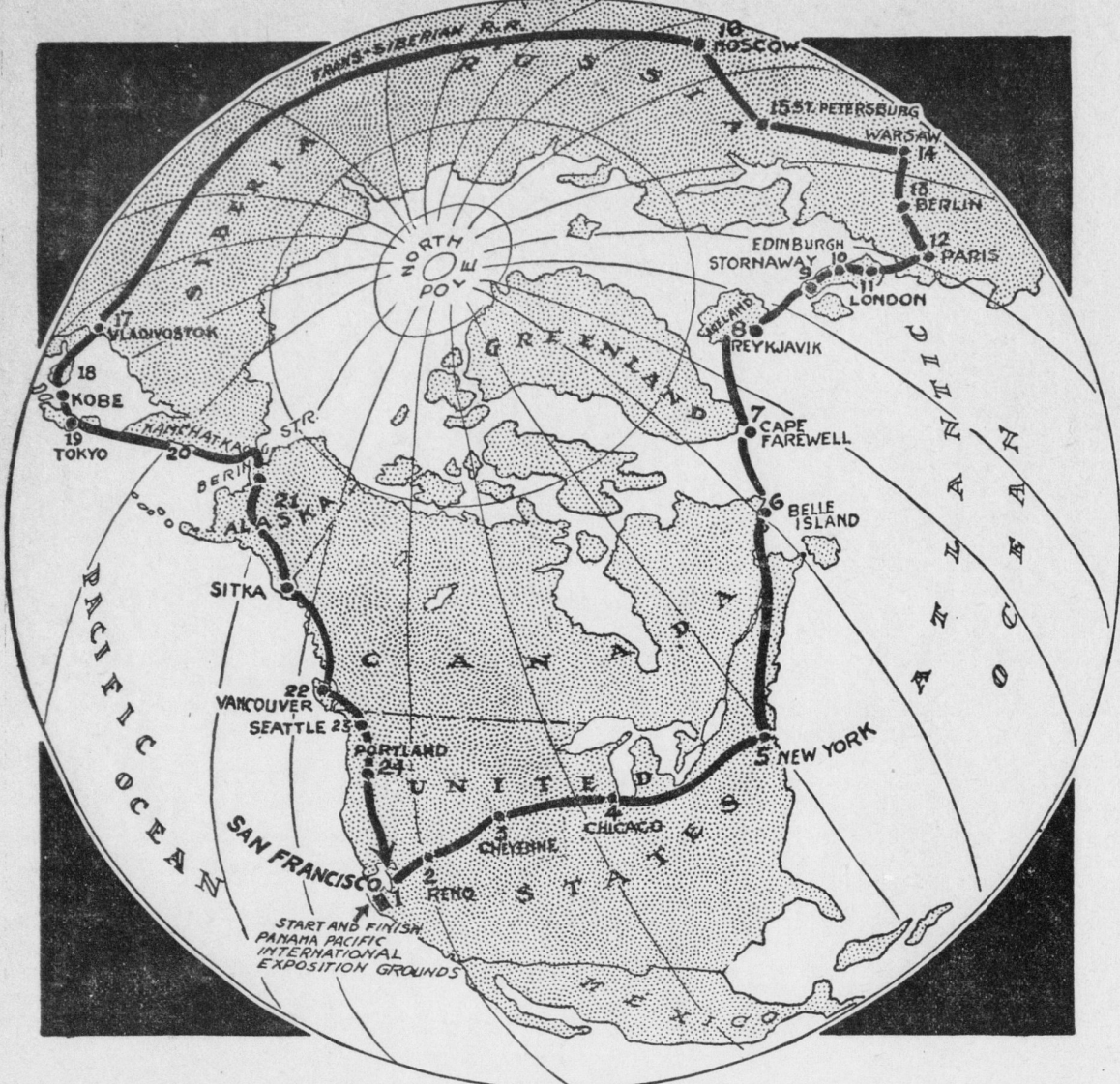


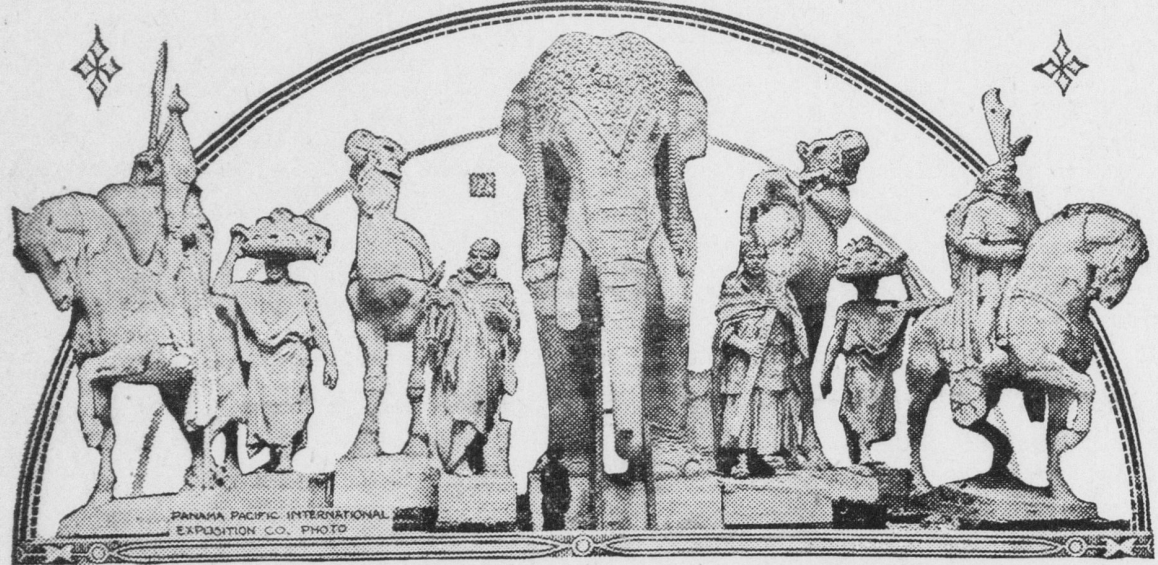
THE PANAMA-PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL AVIATION RACE AROUND THE WORLD.

COLOSSAL GROUP OF STATUARY FOR VAST EXPOSITION COURT—"NATIONS OF THE EAST"

This photograph shows the enlarged figures for the colossal group, "Nations of the East," to crown the Arch of the Rising Sun at the Panama-Pacific International exposition at San Francisco in 1915. With the exception of the elephant and the camel on the left all the figures are completed. The elephant, however, will be surmounted by a howdah and the camel by a rider. The group in its entirety is the conception of A. Stirling Calder, with whom Frederick G. R. Roth and Leo Lentelli cooperated. The huge elephant in the center of the group was modeled by Mr. Roth, who also modeled the camels. The mounted horsemen were modeled by Leo Lentelli. From left to right the figures are: Arab warrior, negro servitor bearing baskets of fruit, camel and rider, falconer, elephant, representing India; Buddhist lama, bearing emblem of authority; camel and rider, negro servitor, Mongolian warrior.
