HOME HEALTH CLUB

What To Do: Diaphoretic.—A diaphoretic is an agent prepared for the purpose of stimulating the circulation and opening up the pores of the skin so as to produce perspiration. One of the best old fashioned remedies, one of which I have often told you, and which I have always called diffusive, is simple, common, hot ginger tea.

One of the best sweating agents, which should be used during the early stages of eruptive diseases, such as measles, chicken pox, small-pox, scarlet fever and also in the fever stage of malaria and many other difficulties, is the formula which I shall now give you in the form of a pleasant and most efficient diaphoretic.

Pleurisy root, 2 ounces; ginger, 1 1/2 ounces; thyme, 1 1/2 ounces sweet marjoram, 1 1/2 ounces. Mix the pulverized article thoroughly and prepare an infusion by steeping a tablespoonful of the mixture in a pint of boiling water.

Poultices—Poultices are applications made to the surface to soften the parts and sometimes used to direct the flow of blood outward from inflamed internal organs.

If there is too free discharge from ulcers, or the tissues are relaxed, the poultices should contain such astringents as witch hazel or wild cherry bark, possible pulverized bayberry bark. When there is great inflammation and tenderness of the parts there is nothing that can equal pulverized lobelia, either the herb or the seed, sprinkled over the poultice.
