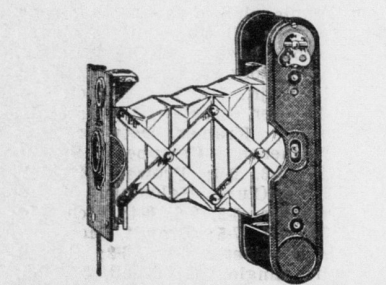

The Lucky or Unlucky Sea Bean, Which is It?

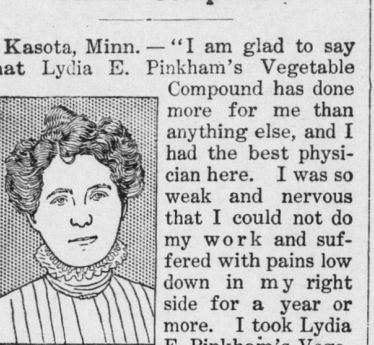
Many newspapers have published stories pro and con of this mysterious product of the deep. How one Sea Bean saved a sailor who was thrown in the midst of a band of cannibals.
