On presentation of this certificate, On presentation of this certificate, duly drawn, the County Commissioners will pay the owner of the injured stock, and if the dog was not licensed he must pay damage in all counts, but if he kills the dog within ten days after notice, he is not required to pay any damages if the dog was licensed.

9.—All police officers, Constables, etc., are allowed \$1 for each dog they may kill under the requirements of this act, and all Magistrates, Auditors or Aldermen who may be called upon to assess and appraise damage done, are allowed \$2 in each case and five cents per mile traveling expenses, which amount is paid by the County Commissioners.
