### SALUNGA DEALER IS PROUD OF HIS HOLSTEIN CATTLE

In line with the modern methods in dairying and pure-bred stock breeding, which resulted in the kind of records and sales that have put Lancaster county on the map in the past few weeks, C. A. Spahr, a prominent and constructive Holstein breeder of Salunga, has recently completed official tests, under the supervision of W. Horace Harper, which place more of his cows in the foreground of the Holstein breeders world.

The last member of Mr. Spahr's herd to join the bovine aristocracy is a Junior 2 years old, Kelco Bertha Pontiac, who is sired by the popular and promising sire, Spring Farm King, owned by F. M. Jones, of New York State. In this sire ancestry has combined the lines of breeding that have produced some of the best animals in the Holstein breed, his sire being a brother to the breed's first 44 pound cow, and that this sire has inherited the good points of his ancestors is proven by the fact that though a comparatively young bull he had up to the present twelve 20 pound two year old daughters, their average being 22.64 pounds of butter in 7 days. Now Mr. Spahr's heifer with her 22.37 pound butter and 509.8 pounds milk in 7 days will add another 20 pound daughter to the credit of Spring Farm King.

On her dam side also, Kelco Bertha Pontiac inherits good breeding her first dam having a 27 pound record and her grand sire and dam being good productive stock. In addition to Kelco Bertha Pontiac Mr. Spahr has a number of A. R. cows in his herd, among whom are the following: Elnora Sarcastle Lyons De Kol, 26.73; Mutual De Kol Saddle, 29.43; Lena Koniger, 3rd, 25.84; Overbrook Daphne, 23.13 pounds butter as mature cows and Tranquility Soldene Jennie 18.56 pounds butter as a senior 2 year old. As a nucleus of a future herd at Pleasant View Mr. Spahr has some very promising young stock among whom is a Junior herd sire Johann Vikina Lad who has a 39 pound grand dam and a sire a brother to Segis Fayne Johanna the first 50 pound cow.

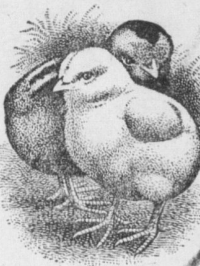

### DAVID SINGER'S GOOD RECORD AS A TEACHER

David Singer, one of the oldest teachers in Lancaster county, has taught his 46th term. He taught his first year at the age of 20, in 1873, at Back Run, Rapho township. He has remained at one school for more than 4 years in succession. The school boards generally shifted to a school where strict discipline was needed. He has taught 22 different schools in Lancaster county, and generally in the townships of Rapho, Mount Joy, Donegal, East Donegal, Conoy, and one term in South Lebanon county. He received \$40 per month salary, and in 1919-1920, he conducted schools which had

enrollments of 84 pupils. He states that in round numbers about 150 of his former pupils have passed to the great beyond.

Mr. Singer holds a permanent certificate never attending a normal school or college.

This last year he walked from Elizabethtown to Wheatland school, located five miles east of the former place every evening and morning.

He has now reached the retirement age of 66 years with 6 years to spare; but claims he will be performing the duties of a school master for many more years if life lasts.

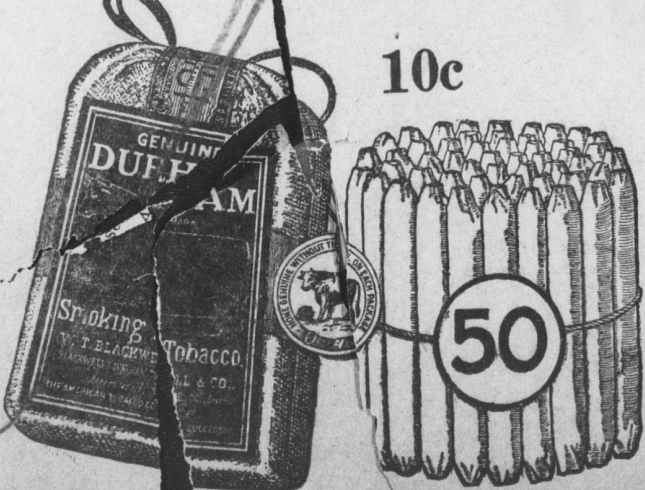
