**WANT GOVERNMENT TO BUY ALL THE WHISKEY**

Purchase by the United States Government of all the whiskey held in bond will be proposed by the "drys" in the near future to put a stop to what they term irregular methods in withdrawals, according to a statement today by Ernest H. Cherrington, secretary of the World League Against Alcoholism, and one of the leaders in the Anti-Saloon League.

The amount of whiskey in bond is estimated at 50,000,000 gallons, and even if purchased at cost price, it would cost the government virtually as many dollars. The "drys," how- ever, contend that with the whiskey in the hands of the federal authorities the enforcement of the prohibition laws would be made much easier and more economical than at the present time.

"I believe the government should purchase the entire remaining stock of liquor at a fair cost price and hold it for medical and sacramental purposes," said Mr. Cherrington. "Under government ownership there would be less likelihood of law viola- tions, and persons who now wish to dispose of it would have accomplished that end in the sale to the govern- ment."






