Herewith is a corrected weekly report of the Lancaster markets relative to produce and live stock:

Lancaster Retail Produce Market All the markets were well attended last evening and this morning. Buyers were out in force and with most commodities in good supply, trading was active. Corn is increasing in supply and is slightly lower. Peas are fast coming to a close and the supply is very limited. Pickles are more plentiful. Butter and eggs are in good supply and sold steady. Other fruits and vegetables were plentiful at prices practically unchanged.

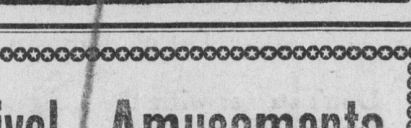
