MAYTOWN

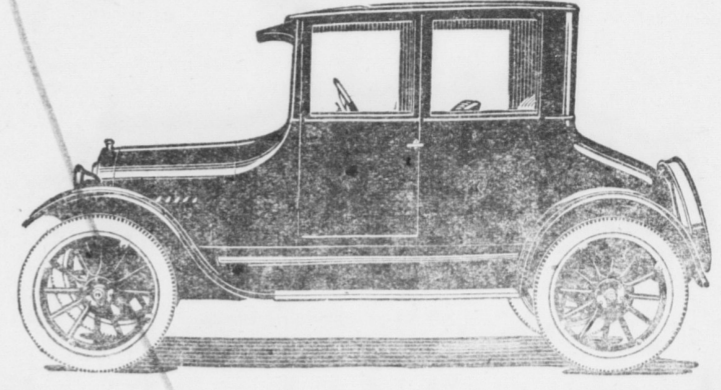
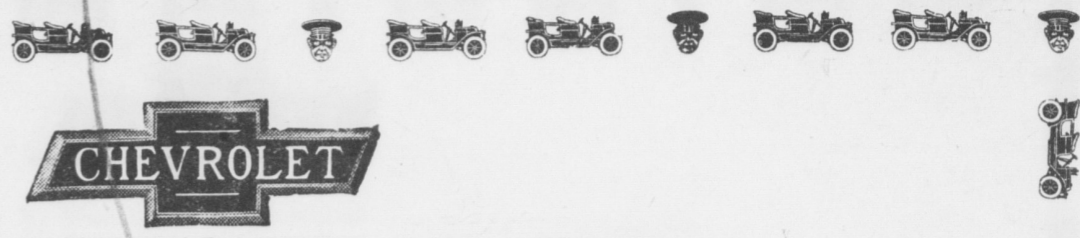
The Maytown band hall was crowded on Saturday evening, when the 1922 Minstrels, an organization from Marietta, gave a production in a very pleasing manner.
