MANY COUNTIES ERADICATE TUBERCULOSIS IN CATTLE

The most important feature of the tuberculosis-eradication movement continues to be cleaning up of definite areas, principally counties, according to the United States Department of Agriculture.

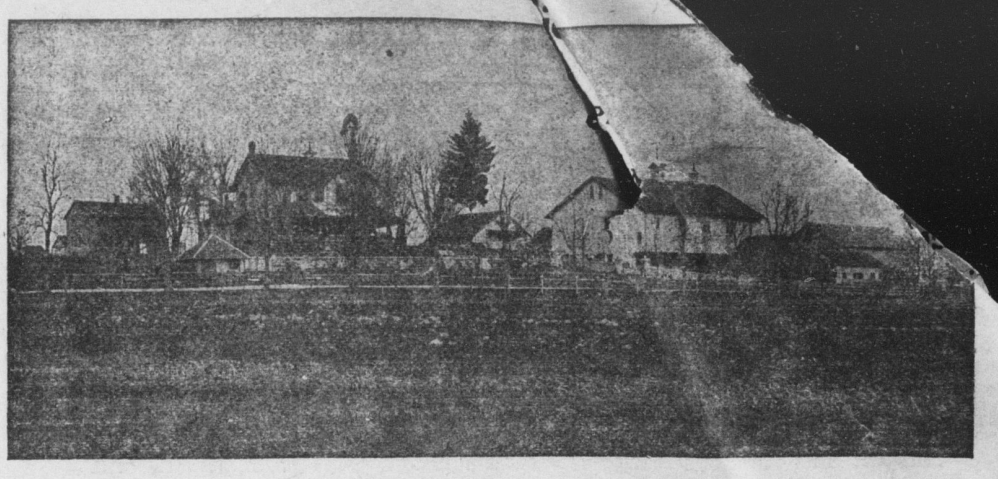
To date the best example of a successful county-wide drive is the one carried on in Steuben County, N. Y. During a period of 19 days there were tested, by veterinarians 4,615 lots containing more than 45,000 head of cattle.

A total of 463 home conveniences was purchased by members of testing circles recently conducted among rural women in the State of Washington, under the supervision of the extension workers of the United States Department of Agriculture.

As a result of trying out labor-saving devices in their homes, 105 women bought pressure cookers for canning and cooking, 96 bought fireless cookers, 75 bought dish drainers, 70 selected utility tables, 60 wanted steam cookers, 24 installed bread mixers, and 13 obtained vacuum cleaners.
