Penns. "44" WHEAT LEADS OTHER VARIETIES IN STATE

Pennsylvania "44" wheat again triumphed over other varieties in Pennsylvania this year.

The results obtained in 13 variety tests conducted on farms in various parts of the state by the agricultural extension department at the Pennsylvania State College show that this variety, which was bred by Professor C. F. Noll of the Experiment Station, out-yielded the other varieties by about five bushels per acre.

This bears out the results obtained in the last four years which have always favored the new wheat. Yields of thirty or more bushels per acre were reported very frequently to State College, compared to the state average of less than twenty.

The increase in the amount of Pennsylvania "44" grown in the state has been phenomenal. Last year there were over 50,000 acres harvested and it is estimated that over 100,000 acres were grown in 1923. The extra yield obtained over Leap's Prolific, Fulcaster, Harvest King and other varieties has influenced many farmers to change to Pennsylvania "44".
