

This destructive insect can be controlled. The recommended control easures are divided into the folowing three important steps: 1. Pick up and destroy all fallen fruit. 2 Cut down wild or volunteer apple rees which cannot be properly cared for. 3. Follow the poison pray schedule as given in detail in he circular.

The circular was prepared by T. L. Guyton and J. N. Knull, entomo logists in the Bureau of Plant Industry. It is sent free to all perons in the State requesting it.
