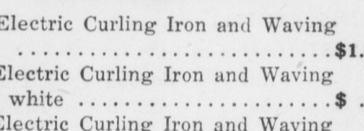

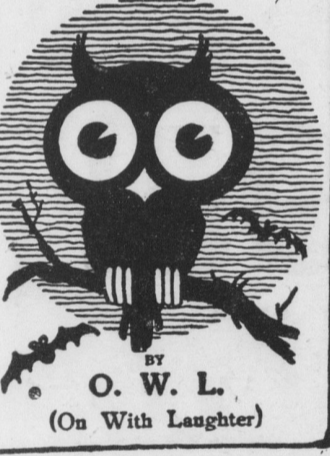

"Itzky" Miller, proprietor of "Tumble Inn," near Landisville, was arrested Thursday on a new charge brought by Mrs. Anna Reichard, of Columbia, mother of two girls seized in the raid conducted by State Police last Saturday, near midnight. The latest complaint against Miller is enticing minors.

 This morning, the two girls, Mrs. Carrie Scotten, wife of Robert S. Scotten, the youth who was recently sentenced to life imprisonment, and her sister, Pearl, appeared before Justice of Peace, Danner, and pleaded guilty to charges of disorderly conduct.
