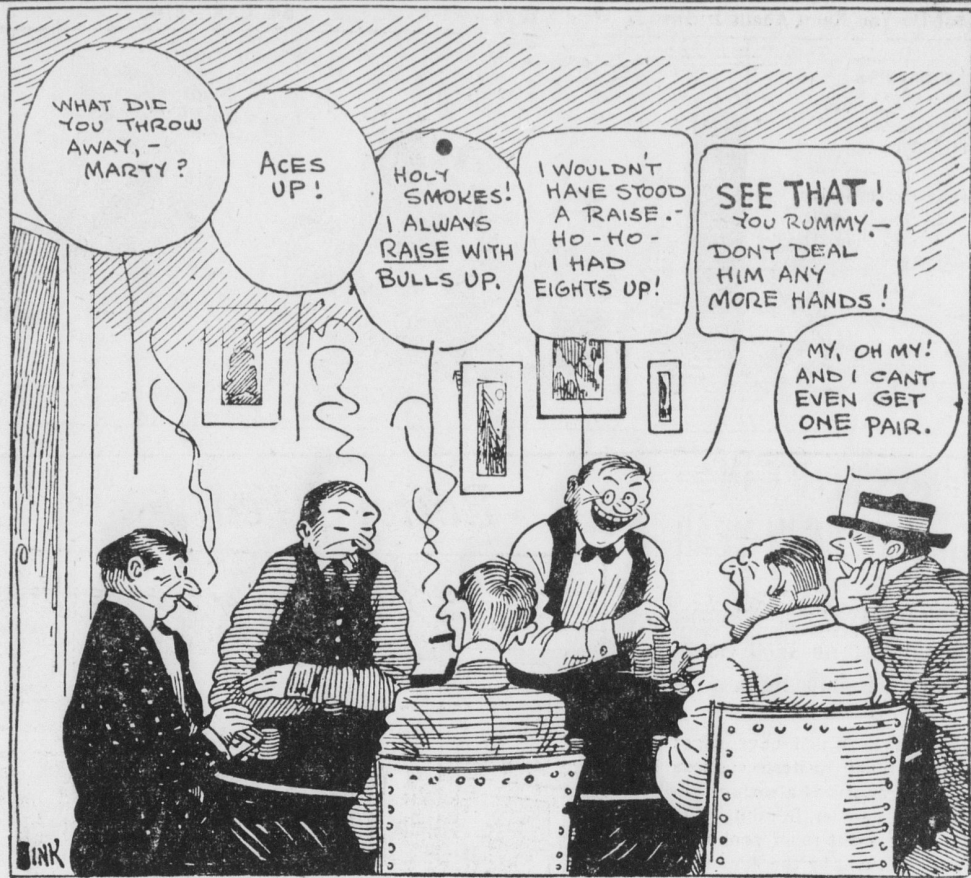

- Change engine oil. Flush transmission and rear with kerosene and refill with fresh lubricant. Remove front wheels and repack with fresh lubricant. Spray springs with penetrating oil. Tune motor. Adjust distributor points. Clean and adjust spark plugs. Clean sediment bulk and carburetor. Adjust intake. Tighten carburetor and exhaust manifolds. Check battery.
