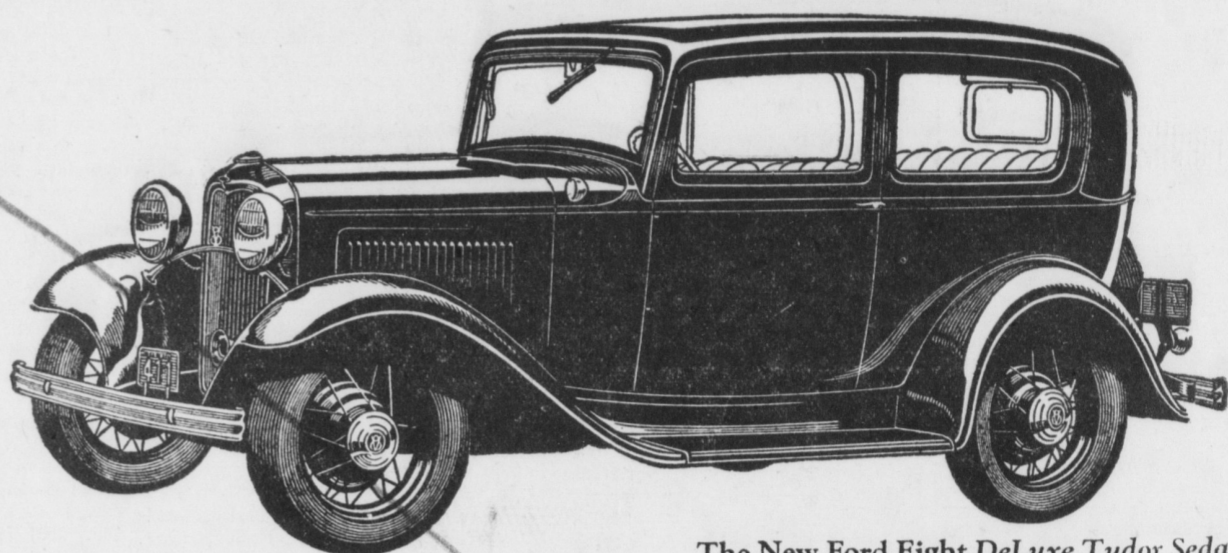

MT. JOY MAN SUED BY HIS WIFE IN DETROIT

The following news item is reprinted from Saturday's Lancaster New Era:

"Detroit, April 9.—Charged with gambling all his earnings away and swearing at his wife when she remonstrated, Leroy H. Mumma, Mt. Joy, today was named defendant in a suit for divorce filed by Mrs. Emma Mumma, of Detroit.

Mrs. Mumma alleges that she was forced to seek employment to support herself. Mumma was jealous, his wife's bill says, and accused her unjustly of associating with other men. The couple married October 18, 1925 and separated January 7, 1930. After their marriage the couple moved to Allentown where they separated. Mr. Mumma returned to the farm of his father, Amos N. Mumma and his wife returned to her home in Detroit.

"It certainly sounds very bad," Mr. Mumma said today when he received news dispatches. "I have not anything to say except that the charges are certainly not true."
