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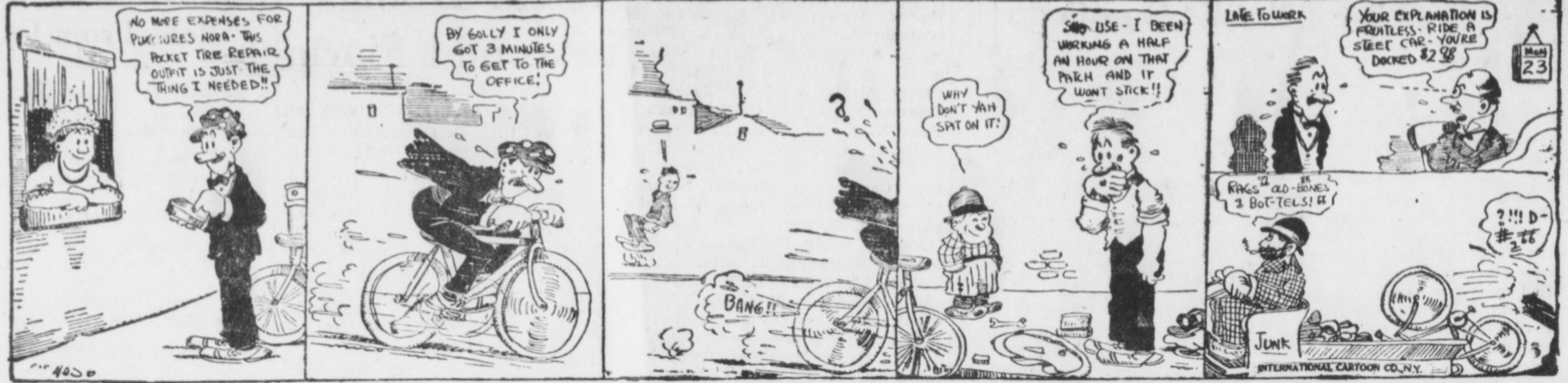

HEALTH TALK

"There is no meaner method of hitting below the belt than by holding out false promises to incurables. This fact, however, does not in the least deter the unscrupulous who thus heartlessly prey upon the acute gullibility of the thousands of unfortunates who are in a hopeless stage of illness. And so it happens that thousands of dollars are annually extracted from the non-too-full pockets of individuals whose conditions direct their hope to the promises made by the super-scientific gentry who claim to have beaten the untiring researchers of endowed laboratories to cures for cancer, diabetes, tuberculosis, epilepsy and other serious conditions," states Dr. Theodore B. Appel, Secretary of Health.

"Unfortunately it is words rather than performance that creates the miracle. A miracle which, instead of being related to a cure, is entirely associated with the transfer of large sums of money from innocent persons to the coffers of those whose interest in the health and health matters ceases at the cash register.

"It is the sad and killing fact that in addition to the incurables, there are thousands of believing persons who become victims of this type of charlatanism, and thus through self-diagnosis and self-treatment, postpone a real investigation of their ailments until the incurable stage has been reached.

"Two main rules should be followed in this connection. The first is regularly to submit to an annual physical examination by a competent physician. In this way incipient conditions can be discovered and by proper treatment the disease can frequently be conquered. The second rule is in all cases to mistrust all high promising allegations of 'amazing discoveries.'

"While there are many commercial medicinal products of merit and value, these differ very much from the type of product which professes to do the impossible. Both incurables and persons in the early stages of serious diseases, or who think they are suffering from such conditions, should avoid them and rely entirely upon professional direction and supervision."

Kill Red Mites
Old engine oil or coal oil can be sprayed or painted on the perches and perch supports to exterminate red mites. 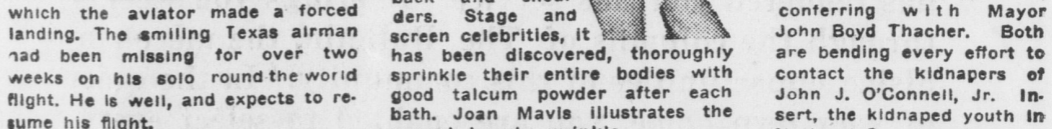

They Must Burn Fuses At Night

ment, imprisonment for not more than 10 days on a summary conviction, is provided for non-compliance with the law.

The signals must be similar to the time burning railway fuse and so constructed as to burn with a brilliant red or yellow light for not less than 15 minutes. They must be displayed continuously when a vehicle becomes disabled, within the limits of the traveled part of the highway, to such an extent that it constitutes a menace to traffic.

Certain operators may be of the opinion that the term "traveled part" of the highway means the improved portion only, the division of safety officials said. Good judgment will have to be used. The "traveled part" of the highway does not necessarily mean the improved portion only.

When a vehicle is disabled and is moved from the improved portion, the division advises operators to determine at once whether the portion of the highway on which the vehicle is parked is used by the other vehicular traffic.
