### Roundup Of 4-H Baby Beef Club Is Held

NINETEEN OF THE THIRTY-FOUR HEAD ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE STATE FARM SHOW AT HARRISBURG NEXT MONTH

The annual roundup of the finished heaves of the 1936 Lancaster County 4-H Baby Beef club was held at the Keller Stock Yards here yesterday.

A total of 34 head of finished calves were shown. They were judged by F. L. Bentley and William B. Connell, and John H. Myers of Lancaster, of the State College Bureau of Animal Husbandry. All the animals were weighed and the complete records compiled.

Only 19 of the animals are eligible to be exhibited at the Harrisburg Farm Show next month according to County Agent F. S. Eucher. "This is based not on quality or grade as such, but on the percentage of animals that can be accommodated at the State Show, after considering the total 4-H enrollment in the state. In other words, only 56 per cent of the baby heaves fed by club members in Pennsylvania can go to the Harrisburg Show. The eliminations of the local animals will be promptly at 10 a. m.

The surplus animals of the local club were sold at public sale at 1:30 in the afternoon at the Keller barns.

The highest sales price was \$12-50 per hundredweight for a 1000-pound animal. The low was \$9.50 for a steer weighing 570 pounds. The buyers were: Philadelphia Dressed Beef Company; Hershey Department Store, F. C. Browning; H. H. Krall; and J. Loyd Hollinger.

Thirty-four entries were originally scheduled for the roundup, but Thomas McGee, of Manheim township, withdrew at the last minute. The second heaviest steer shown was that belonging to Leroy Hawthorne, of Marietta. The beef tipped the scales at 1210 pounds.

Fifty farmers, exhibitors and cattle raisers were present at the exhibition. The complete list of prize winners is as follows: Rufus Grube, Rothsville; Robert Shank,
