Be it resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mt. Turn into a greased casserole or individual ramekins, sprinkle buttered crumbs on top with grated cheese over all and bake in moderate oven of 375 degrees for twenty minutes. Garnish with parsley and cut lemon. This amount serves four to six.
