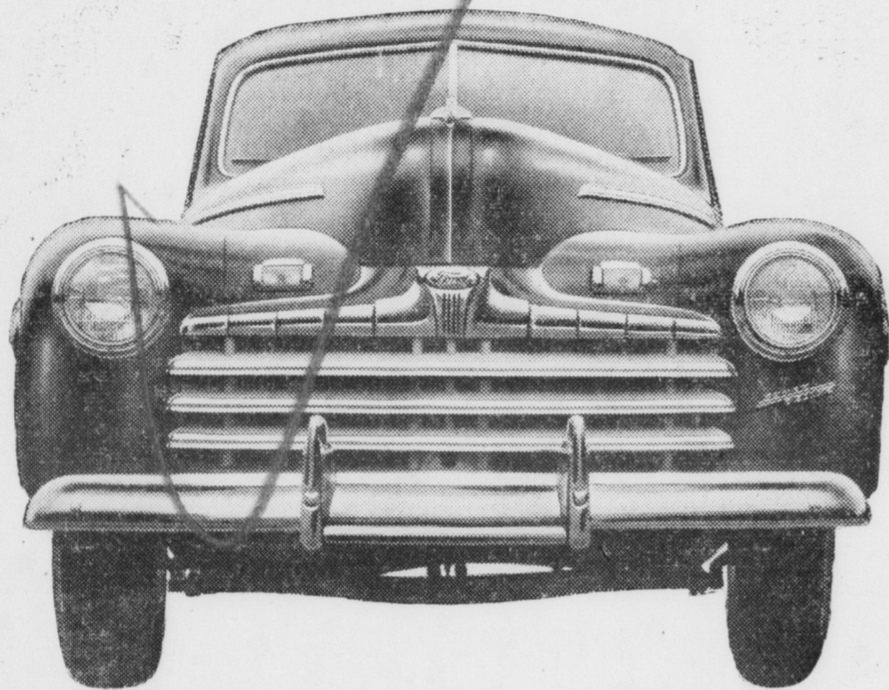

## Thank Offering Service

In his address, Pastor Fritz pointed out the fact that the church had followed its men into the camps, and into combat. The contacts the soldier has had on the far flung islands of the earth with native Christians, has produced in him a healthy respect for the world missionary program of the Church.
