On Sunday, July 20th, Dr. Levi H. Zerr, Superintendent of the West District, will deliver a memorial sermon at 11:00 a.m. The Hamilton Chorus, under the direction of Abram Longenderfer, will present a musical program at 2:30 p.m. The evening worship service, at 7:45 o'clock, will feature a sermon by Dr. John H. Ness, Superintendent of the Pennsylvania Conference of the Evangelical United Brethren Church.
