Bainbridge Man Tells (From page 1) ing on Walcheran Island, Good helped in the job of reconstruction on bomb-wrecked lands flooded when the dikes were opened by the German occupation forces shortly after the Allied invasion of the continent.

"When the Germans opened the dikes in the face of the advancing Allies, the soil was ruined. Several thick layers of salt beds cover the once fertile land which will not produce crops for approximately eight more years," Good said.

"But in other parts of Europe this year, the crop is very promising. Whenever one travels rich fields of needed grains and vegetables are flourishing."

After finishing the reconstruction job in Holland, Good was sent into Germany, where he distributed relief supplies for four months.

"In contrast to Holland, where the morale is comparatively high," he said, "the morale in Germany is at its lowest ebb. I had heard that food shortage was critical, but I had to be there to see just how terrible it really is. In Germany, like almost all Western European countries, food is rationed.

"Everywhere people are hungry. Thousands are homeless and are living in cellars, bombed-out buildings, and any place they can find. One can easily see the effects of
