NEWTOWN New Co. School (From Page 1) to bring about final elimination of the century-old system by which county schools are still managed by about 60 different boards.

A State Law approved by the last session of the State Legislature requires each county superintendent to prepare a plan for the merger and reorganization of School Districts, and present the plan by July 1948 to the State Department of Education.

Each superintendent was given two choices. First he would suggest a plan for actual merger of school districts in his county. Second, he could suggest a plan for joint operation of School Boards. The latter plan permits each district to retain a School Board but provides that certain districts get together to pool their resources for the common good of all.

Here is how Dr. Mylin recommends local districts pool their interests:

Unit 1 — Conoy and East Donegal Twp. and Marietta borough.

Unit 2 — Elizabethtown and Mt. Joy boroughs, Mount Joy and West Donegal Townships.

Unit 3 — Manheim borough, Penn and Rapho Townships.
