NEW PROTESTANT FILM TO BE SHOWN IN ELIZABETHTOWN

Following its premiere showing in Lancaster and Harrisburg and 98 other selected cities in the United States and Canada, the second production of the Protestant Film Commission, "My Name Is Han", will be presented this coming Sunday evening, June 20, in the Washington Street Church of the Brethren, Elizabethtown. Made available by the Foreign Missions Commission of the Church of the Brethren, the picture will provide a new insight into the status of Christianity in China. The Chinese are now providing their own missionaries so that it is now possible to make a picture of Christian missions without showing a single Occidental. The picture is being released to coincide with the launching of a mission study program on China during the year 1948-1949 in the Protestant churches. This film focuses attention on one of the most significant movements in recent church history, the attempt to use the moving picture as a means of communicating the Christian message.

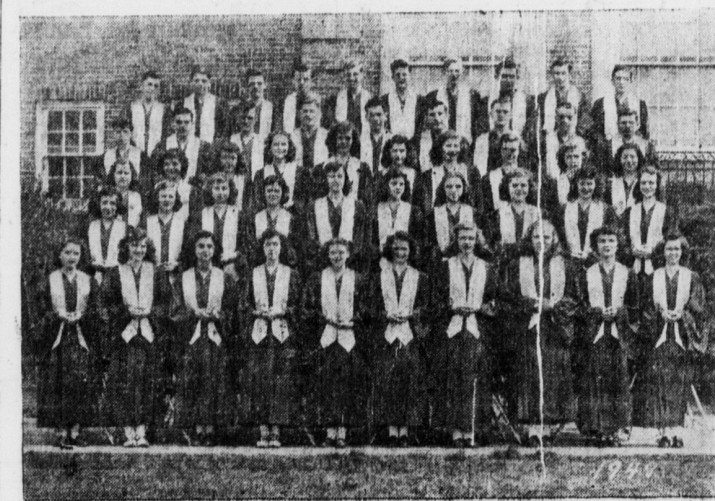

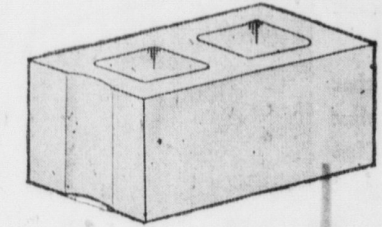

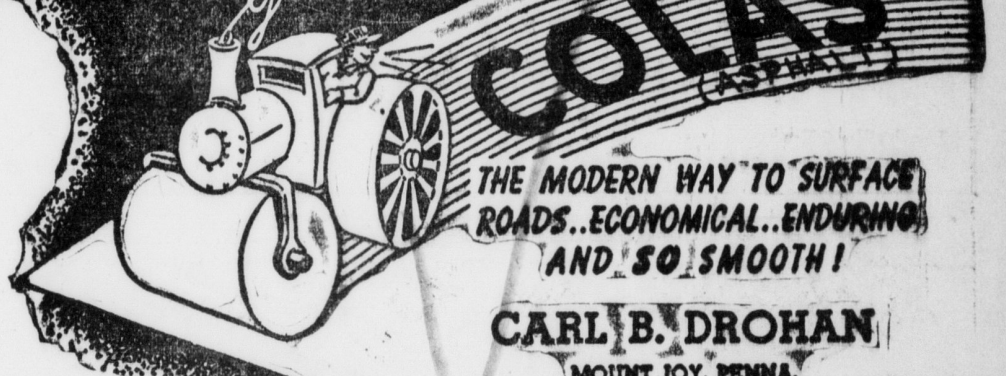
