

As long as a single infected animal remains, there will always be danger of spreading tubercu-losis to a disastrous number of

cattle. The last source of infection must be eliminated before we can let up in this fight.

Periodic testing of herds, on a herd or area basis, is the only way to be sure that new and serious flare-ups of bovine T.B. will not occur. In areas where tuberculosis appeared in recent years, veterinarians are advising yearly tests. In areas long free of the disease, it may not be necessary to make tests oftener than every two or three years. Following the tests, reactors should be slaughtered. Govern-ment funds are available to com-

pensate the owners of the cattle Livestock health authorities throughout the country are active in efforts to finish off the fight against tuberculosis. 
