Young Veteran Will Give Piano Recital
Cleo Bernard Shank, twenty year old pianist from Blue Ridge Summit, Penna., and brother of Rev. Roscoe W. Shank, Vicar of St. Andrews, will give a benefit recital for the St. Andrew's Episcopal church, York, Pa. All financial benefit will be added to the building fund for the new church now being constructed on the corner of Ogentz and Fourth Avenues, in York.
Mr. Shank has studied piano since a small boy and also studied organ for many years but gave that up in favor of piano studies of advanced nature. While studying under Mr. Joseph Bowers of Blue Ridge Summit and before going in the Army, he gave and participated in several recitals. He also studied under Mr. Asher Edelman, Hagerstown, Maryland.
During Mr. Shank's eighteen months of service in the Army, he played both piano and organ in the Earnie Pyle Theatre in Japan, played for Service Shows in the Special Service Detachment and while with the U. S. Armed Forces in Korea he gave four recitals by request.

Army Air Force repair, storage and replacement center as well as an emergency landing field, it was stated. At present the depot supplies Air Force bases in a 15-state area, extending from Maine to Michigan to Virginia. It is the world's largest aircraft instrument supplier. Jet engines are overhauled there.
No information was available as to what effect, if any, inactivation of the Olmstead Depot as a flying field would have on the present working force. Army spokesmen were emphatic that it was "not going to be abandoned in any sense of the word."
The Middletown field has two runways, one 4500 feet long and the other 5000 in length, large enough for smaller aircraft such as the C-54s and C-47s but there is no way of expanding the base, it was pointed out. It is strategically located in an area with 42 percent of the nation's population.
