Every Sunday during the month a trap shoot is being held at the local field. Hunters are invited out to practice for the coming season.

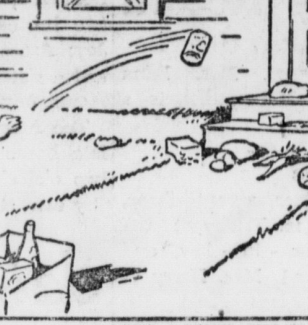
After the business session, Mr. Martin Miller, showed several films on hunting and fishing, to which the Boy Scouts were invited to see.
