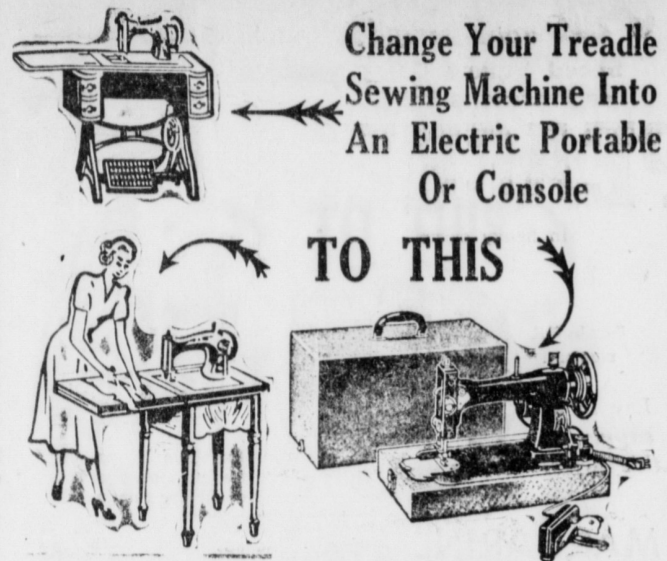


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### BIBLE SCHOOL JULY 18-29 AT CROSS ROADS CHURCH

the ministry after leaving F. & M. College in 1933 and became an ordained minister at the age of 20 years. He received his degree in 1940 from the Los Angeles Bible College and in 1947 received his THD having done the graduate work for this degree at the University of Redlands, Calif. and the Baptist College of Los Angeles. Dr. Fisher is also a well known author having written 12 books on the religious and prophetic line.

This one-week campaign with Mr. Fisher will give many of his local friends the first opportunity to hear him since he entered the ministry nearly 15 years ago. He has been speaking throughout America in such large churches as Angelus Temple in Los Angeles where he recently conducted services for four consecutive Sundays, speaking to thousands.

Some of Dr. Fisher's subjects to be delivered are as follows:  
"Is There Really A God, Can This Fact Be Proved?" This subject will deal with refutation of Atheism and Evolution etc.  
"The Prince of Peace and the UNO". This sermon will deal with Dr. Fisher's recent visit to the halls of the World Security Council Room at the UNO Headquarters at Lake Success, New York. He will answer the question, Will there be war or peace in 1950? Will the UNO preserve the world peace?  
"Is The Soul of Man Really Immortal, Can This Be Proved Both Biblically and Scientifically?" This sermon will answer the questions: Does the soul sleep in the grave after death? Will we know our loved ones after death? Is there really a burn-

ing Hell and after death punishment?  
"The Destiny of the World Churches and the Western Nation In the Light of Bible Prophecy."  
"The Prophetic Destiny of Soviet Russia." This sermon will deal with the momentous questions: When and where will Russia strike? Is the next war armageddon?

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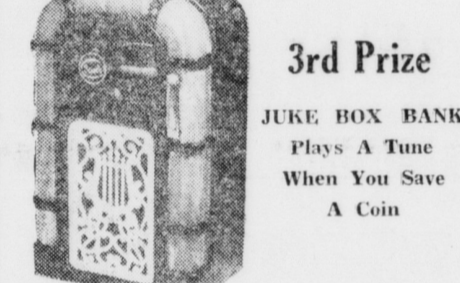

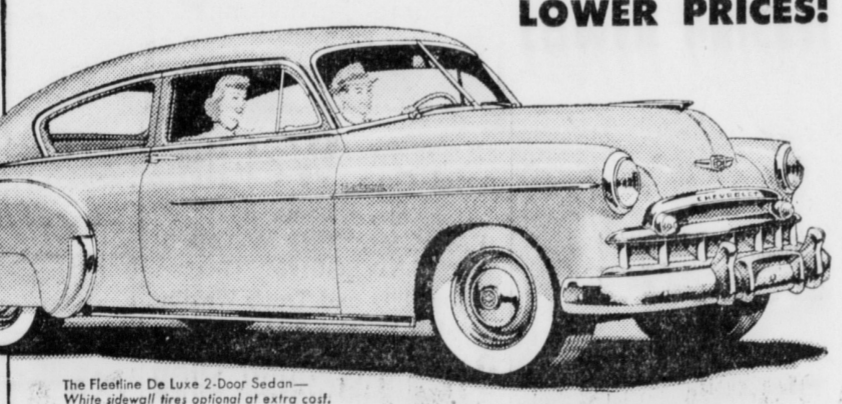
