





the ministry after leaving F. M. College in 1933 and became an ordained minister at the age of He received his degree in 1940 from the Los Angeles Bible College and in 1947 received his THD having done the graduate work for this degree at the University of Redlands, Calif. and the Baptist College of Los Angeles. Dr. Fisher is also well known author having written 12 books on the religious and prophetic line.


