**HARVEY RETTEW'S FRE-RUS GIPSY WAYNE MAKES RECORD**  
Fre-Rus Gipsy Wayne, a registered Holstein Friesian cow owned by Harvey Rettew, Manheim, has completed a 365 day production test of 572 pounds of butterfat and 17340 pounds of milk made in Herd Improvement Registry.

Testing was supervised by Pa. State College in cooperation with The Holstein - Friesian Assoc. of America.

This cow was milked two times daily and was 8 years 11 months old when she began her test period.

**AN ORDINANCE**  
Granting to PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, its successors, assigns and lessees, permission and consent to erect and maintain electric line facilities upon certain property of the BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY.

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY:

**SECTION 1.** That permission and consent be and the same is hereby granted to PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY to erect and maintain its electric line facilities, comprising two (2) poles and an anchor guy, as well as overhanging wires, upon, over and across property of the BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY in the vicinity of Barbara Street and State Highway Legislative Route No. 36002, in the Township of Mount Joy, as particularly indicated in red on PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY's plan No. LA-32883-1, dated August 4, 1949, hereto attached and entitled "Mt. Joy Distribution System - Plan showing electric line right of way over property of Mt. Joy Boro, Mt. Joy Twp., Lancaster, Pa.;" and to cut down, trim, remove and keep cut down and trimmed any and all trees, brush or other unfergrowth on said property which may at any time interfere with the construction, reconstruction, maintenance or operation of said electric line facilities, or menace the same.

**SECTION 2.** That said electric line facilities shall be erected and maintained in a workmanlike manner at the locations and in accordance with the aforesaid plan. Should the said electric line facilities at any time interfere with repairs or alterations made by the BOROUGH OF MOUNT JOY on the said property, then PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY shall, at its expense, relocate said facilities so as to avoid such interference.

**SECTION 3.** That a certified copy of this ordinance shall be recorded hereof by PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY shall be filed by PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and this ordinance shall thereafter become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Public Utility Law.

**SECTION 4.** That the permission and consent hereby granted shall extend to the said PENNSYLVANIA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, its successors, assigns and lessees.

**SECTION 5.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
