

BURNING FIELD RESEMBLED THE NORTHERN LIGHTS

Residents of Landisville may have thought they glimpsed what appeared to be northern lights shortly after dark Friday but it was only a field being burned off on a farm about two miles northeast of that place.

Owner of the farm Wayne Hottenstein, Lanc. RD8 had said he had told a group of seasonal farm workers, who have been living on his place to burn off the field before they leave. Asked if they could do it Friday night Hottenstein gave his consent, he said seeing that no buildings were en-

dangered. The flames were visible within a two mile radius according to nearby residents who viewed the county styled aurora borealis.

Hunting Season Opens In Penna. Tuesday, Nov. 1

Hundreds of thousands of hunters will take to the field on Nov. 1 when Pennsylvania's small game season is ushered in. Last year 853,227 resident and 28,120 non-resident licenses had been issued in Pennsylvania, and it is expected that there will be more in 1949. Resident license fees have been increased to \$3.15 and non resident fees to \$20.

The bag limit for rabbits remains the same as last year, four a day or 20 for the season ending on Nov. 28. Twenty squirrels, instead of 24, is the bag limit for 1949. Red squirrels may be taken in unlimited numbers except during the month of October. Thirty-five racoons may be caught this year instead of 30 as previously, while bag limits for grouse, Bobwhite quail, Hungarian partridges and wild turkeys and pheasants are the same as those of 1948.

Local sportsmen think we have about the usual crop of small game thru-out this locality.
