scene shortly after noon he discovered two badly damaged autos, with the body of the deceased sitting upright in the one car. He said that at the fatality scene, the highway is four lanes wide, separated into two lanes by a concrete divider.

There were no witnesses and no operators at the scene. Fliss went to St. Joseph's Hospital, and interviewed the injured.

Summy told him he testified, he was traveling east from Mount Joy at about 50 miles per hour and faintly saw a car approaching in the other direction. Summy had looked in the rear view mirror and saw nothing, he told Fliss, then proceeded to make his turn onto the rural road leading to East Petersburg.

His car was struck on the right side. His wife Marie, who was seriously injured, was sitting in the center of the front seat, and his father-in-law was on the right side.

Summy was found not guilty of manslaughter on the above charge. He was ordered to pay the costs.

The verdict was returned by a jury of seven men and five women in a trial begun late Monday afternoon.
