ALL MERCHANDISE WILL  
REQUIRE PRICE TAGS JULY 1  
Beginning July 1 all articles  
bought in department and similar  
retail stores, except meat and food,  
will require a price tag.

Joseph J. McBryan, acting director  
of the regional Office of Price  
Stabilization, said the tags must be  
in a conspicuous place and must  
carry the selling price of the article.  
That price must be no higher  
than the OPS ceiling price.

In cases where goods normally  
are sold from bins or shelves, price  
tags are not required. McBryan  
said, however, the price must be  
marked plainly on the bin and every  
item in the bin must sell for  
the same price and must be of a  
grade not lower than that formerly  
offered at the same price.

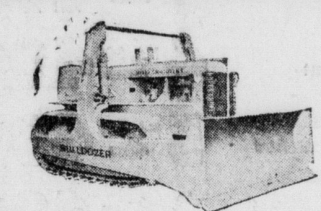

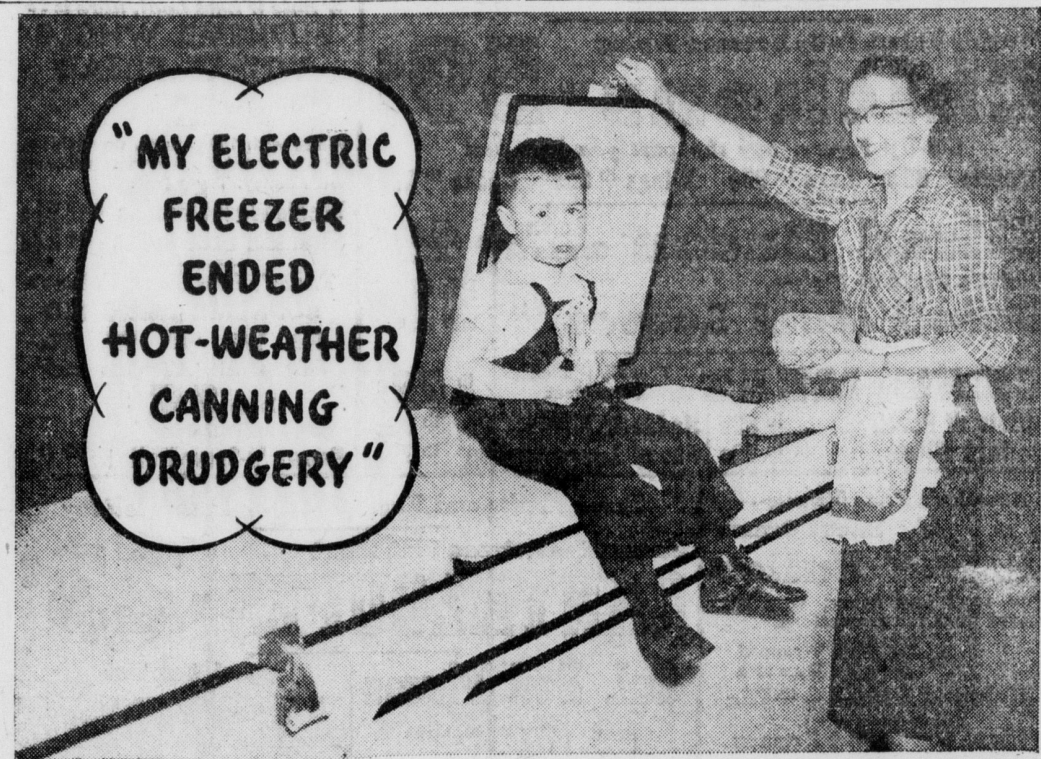
