EDITORIAL

When one prospers he should never begrudge another's prosperity.

America became great through public ownership—but we don't mean the kind of public ownership the Socialist-minded bureaucrats mean. We refer to the corporations which have made this the mightiest industrial nation in the world. They are owned by the people—the stockholders—and they are owned directly by the people, without governmental interference or direction.

When the people—at least, when a majority of the people—of this country decide they wish to make a change in the policies which are daily causing bad matters to become worse, those policies will be changed. But the people regard the government as a benevolent and dotting parent, rather than as a personal responsibility, just as long will we continue to head toward a complete socialistic state.

The Manheim Junior Chamber of Commerce has certainly struck a keynote entitled, "Meet Manheim." It will include a brief history of that boro, a map of the town, a complete list and information concerning all civic groups, churches, recreational facilities, etc. together with a listing of all business and industry. Every new resident of the boro is given a book.

This is a capital idea and should be duplicated in all the other county boros. Why don't one of our civic clubs do something like that here?

Several weeks ago the writer suggested that our Boro Authority give the many springs through this locality some consideration while in the act of improving Mount Joy's water system. Being very familiar with every spring through this entire community, it is a pleasure to enlighten everybody relative thereto.

First, we must bear in mind that if there were no springs, there would be no streams. Inasmuch as we have so many through this locality, would it not be a good idea to harness a number of the larger ones. After the sparkling water leaves a spring, it need not flow any great distance until same can readily be polluted or contaminated, so why not get this water at its source.

About the largest spring in this locality is at Donegal. This widely known place was appropriately named Donegal Springs because there are so many strong flowing springs in a very small area.

The one in the Presbyterian church yard there would supply a town many times the size of Mount Joy. Under the brick property (formerly Hoover's) now owned by the Cameron estate, is a spring almost as strong as the one in the church yard.

.....
Within 100 yards of the above, under another Cameron owned property, is another wonderful spring. The latter two produce as much water as the large Donegal spring. These three springs form the Donegal creek and everybody around here is familiar with the large amount of good clear, pure water flowing seaward from this source.

There are also a number of other springs in our immediate vicinity. On a tract of land owned by the writer, at the southern boro limits there are five springs within a radius of several hundred feet. Two of these are exceptionally strong, even during dry spells.

The foregoing may at least be food for thought.

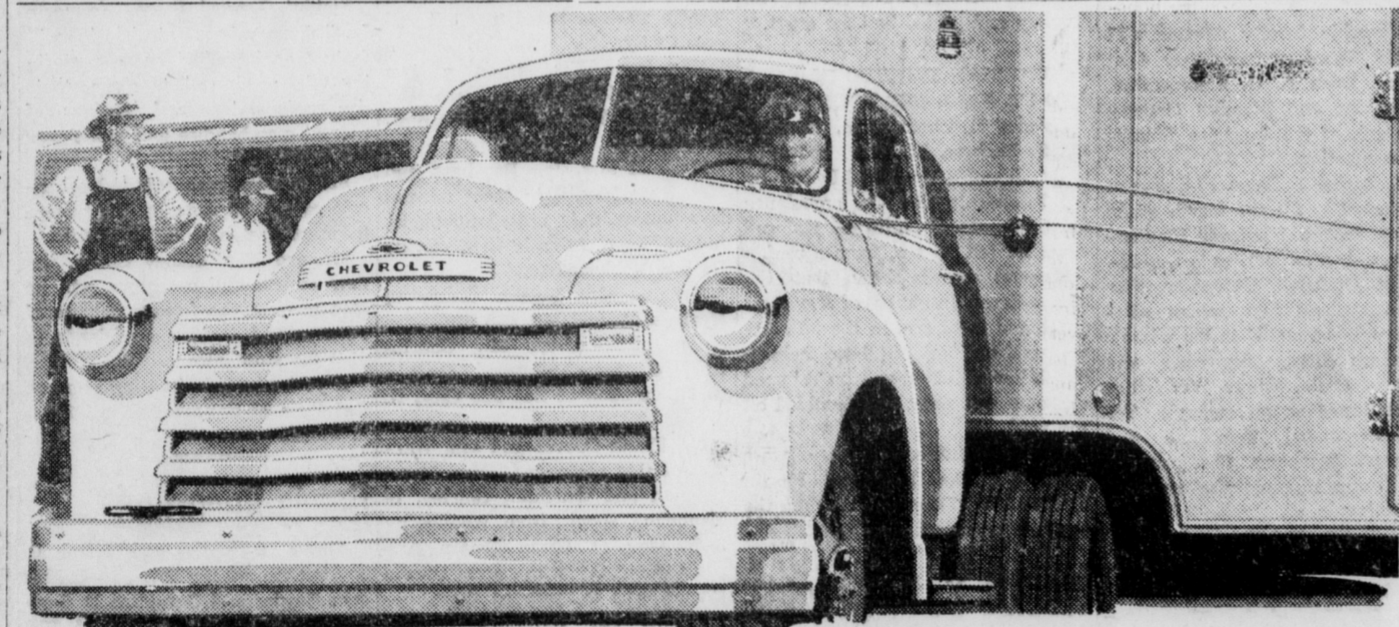
